The Project involved the construction of a community garden on behalf of the Fairlie Organic Growers Association.

The Association aimed to develop a community garden to actively counter climate change by demonstrating the benefits of processing organic waste, growing local food and supporting healthy lifestyles.

The garden was constructed and developed from a former derelict brownfield site and includes multiple planting beds, raised planters, outbuildings, polytunnel and composting facilities.

With financial support from North Ayrshire Council, Caley Construction Ltd worked in partnership with the Fairlie Organic Growers Association and project partners to develop the project. Construction was phased over a two month period and completed in spring 2008.
